1 Application documents

Along with the application form for admission the following application documents have to be submitted:

- 1.1 CV in tabular form.
- 1.2 Motivation letter proving your interest in the desired field of study (max. one page)
- 1.3 You will get a confirmation to your application form approx. 4 weeks after application deadline.
- 1.4 In particular for the postgraduate study course Animation/Technical Directing: Please hand in evidence of a diploma, bachelor's or master's degree of a university or college in subjects such as computer science, media, mathematics, etc. Good programming skills are required as well as a general interest in working in the media business, this can be demonstrated with certificates and work samples.
- 1.5 A residence permit has to be submitted by the time of enrollment.
- 1.6 Proof of high school diploma and a diploma, bachelor's or master's degree (officially certified).

2 Work samples

In addition to the materials mentioned above applicants for Animation/Technical Directing are required to submit a work sample to prove their eligibility:

Demo reel, publication, demo movies, film clip (maximum length 5 minutes, online only, no physical media) and/or executable programmes as a **URL download**. Please state and describe in detail your contribution to the work. **We do not accept CD-ROMs!**

- 3.1 Should your application qualify for a close-pitch selection, the entrance examination will be held on site by a multiple-stage entrance examination.
