postgraduate course Interactive Media/Transmedia Games Producing

Application deadline (date of postmark): 15 May 2021

1 Application documents

The following application documents must be submitted when applying for a place on courses:

- 1.1 Evidence of general/subject-related university entrance qualification of a diploma, Bachelor or Master in business/economics, law, arts and humanities, natural sciences, journalism or in a related discipline and evidence of, as a rule, six months of professional practice in film and TV production, media production or multimedia/online media/games, as well as evidence of special aptitude in the form of work samples.
- 1.2 CV in table format (typewritten/computer file)
- 1.3 Motivation letter explaining your interest in the chosen field of study (max. 1 A4 page)

And for foreign applicants (m/f/x):

- 1.4 Evidence of a satisfactory command of German (Basic Knowledge II) DSH, Deutsche Sprachprüfung für den Hochschulzugang; does not apply for applicants (m/f/x) for Animation specialising in Technical Directing.
- 1.5 Foreign applicants (m/f/x) who have a foreign school-leaving certificate (A Level) must present this certificate to the following institution to establish equivalence with the German school-leaving qualification (Abitur) before submitting their application to the Filmakademie: Staatliche Akademie der Bildenden Künste Stuttgart/State Academy of Fine Arts Stuttgart, Abteilung für Studien- und Prüfungsangelegenheiten, Am Weißenhof 1, 70191 Stuttgart.
- 1.6 The residence permit must be presented at the time of enrolment at the latest.

2 Work samples

In addition to the application documents listed above, you must also submit a work sample:

- 2.1 1 work sample in the form of a breakdown of the budget (financial plan/costing), a statement of resource usage and production planning taking into consideration the use of technology for a planned project or a project already implemented by the applicant (m/f/x). Based on the production documents, produce a brief analysis of the project and of the role you played in it.
If the interactive application is not accessible online, the applicant (m/f/x) must provide it (if necessary in the form of a trailer, play-through, etc.). The material and/or data carrier (mobile end devices, e.g. iPad or USB stick, 3.0 preferred) can be freely chosen.
Playback devices not available on sale, e.g. C64, must be provided.
The work sample should demonstrate your producing skills for the Interactive Media field of study.
The data submitted will, of course, be treated confidentially in accordance with GDPR.



3 General

- 3.1 Please do not use complex and elaborate packaging.
- 3.2 If sending by post, make sure you have enough stamps to cover the postage.
- 3.3 You will receive confirmation of receipt of your application documents around 4 weeks after the application deadline or after formal sorting.
- 3.4 Please include a €5 note for return postage for your work sample and documents.
- 3.5 Filmakademie Baden-Wuerttemberg cannot assume any responsibility for application documents or work samples that are lost when sent back to applicants (m/f/x).
- 3.6 Education at the Filmakademie Baden-Wuerttemberg can generally, in compliance with the legal criteria and provisions, be supported through BAföG.
- 3.7 The entrance examinations/tests will be held between 15 March and 15 July.
- 3.8 Please note that the state of Baden-Württemberg has been charging fees for international students (m/f/x) from non-EU countries since winter semester 2017/2018.
- 3.9 No second degree fees are charged for postgraduate courses at FABW.



Checklist of documents that must be submitted

- Printed and signed application form
- Photo
- Certificate of general/subject-linked university entrance qualification and of a diploma, Bachelor or Master degree – officially certified –
- Evidence of the required practical experience in the media sector
- Evidence of previous studies (certificate of study + certificate of exmatriculation)
- CV in table format (not handwritten)
- Motivation letter explaining your interest in the chosen field of study (max. 1 A4 page)
- Work sample
- If applicable: Short summary of your work sample (max. half A4 page)
- €5 note for returning the submitted application documents

And for foreign applicants (m/f/x):

- Evidence of adequate command of German (DSH)
- Evidence of recognition of the foreign educational qualification by the State Academy of Fine Arts, Stuttgart

- Documents complete
